

Messenger Personal Transmitters

The Messenger Personal Transmitters can be used to send emergency alarm information to a central monitoring station or an emergency contact via a MainStreet Messenger or Voice Messenger in-room unit, System 200 common area receiver, or the System 20 wireless emergency call system. The transmitters can also be utilized to answer a terminal when it rings, remotely dial a telephone number, or send daily check-in notification to a central monitoring station.

They are designed to be fully waterproof. Their FM transmission offers superior signaling, reliability, range and integrity and is designed to work up to 30 meters (100 feet) from the Messenger terminal. These small, attractive wireless transmitters may be conveniently worn on the wrist, around the neck, or affixed to a wall. The call button uses a long-life battery, which lasts approximately five years. When the battery runs low, or the call button is damaged, the call button must be replaced. If battery supervision is enabled, the call button notifies the central monitoring station when the battery runs low.
